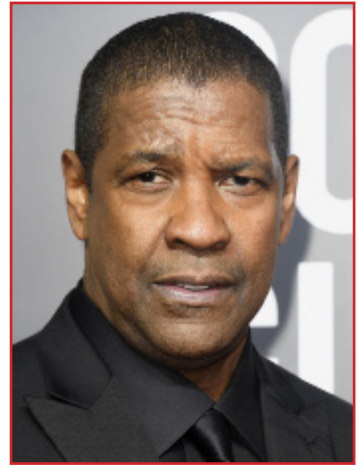

Feb. 7: *Eve's Bayou* (1997)

After a daughter witnesses her father having an affair, she begins a chain reaction that could tear her family apart. Directed by Kasi Lemmons. Rated R. 1 hour, 49 minutes.

Feb. 14: *Love and Basketball* (2000)

Monica and Quincy love and play basketball together through many life challenges from childhood to adulthood. Directed by Gina Prince-Bythewood. Rated PG-13. 2 hours, 4 minutes.

Feb. 21: *Waiting to Exhale* (1995)

Follow four women as they negotiate their relationships with men and each other. Directed by Forest Whitaker. Rated R. 2 hours, 4 minutes.

Feb. 28: *Fences* (2016)

A working-class African-American father tries to raise his family in the 1950s, while coming to terms with the events of his life. Directed by Denzel Washington. Rated PG-13. 2 hours, 9 minutes.
