Feb. 1: *King in the Wilderness* (2018)

A documentary that looks at Martin Luther King, Jr.'s final years. Rated PG-13. 1h, 51m.

Feb. 8: *Loving* (2016)

This is the story of Richard and Mildred Loving, a couple whose arrest for interracial marriage in 1960s Virginia began a legal battle that would end with the Supreme Court's historic 1967 decision. Rated PG-13. 2h, 3m.

Feb. 15: *Marshall* (2017)

Thurgood Marshall, the crusading lawyer who became the first African-American Supreme Court Justice, battles through one of his career-defining cases. Rated PG-13. 2h, 3m.

Feb. 22: *Soundtrack of the Revolution* (2009)

The civil rights struggle is looked at through the powerful and stirring songs that inspired a generation. Not Rated. 1h, 22m.

Feb. 29: *A Ballerina's Tale* (2015)

A documentary that explores the life and career of African-American ballerina Misty Copeland alongside themes of race and body image in the elite ballet world. Unrated. 1h 25m.
