Oct. 11: *The Color Purple* (1986)

A black Southern woman struggles to find her identity after suffering abuse from her father and others over four decades. Starring Oprah Winfrey, Danny Glover and Whoopi Goldberg. Rated PG-13. 2 hours, 34 minutes.

Oct. 18: *The Immortal Life of Henrietta Lacks* (2017)

An African-American woman becomes an unwitting pioneer for medical breakthroughs when her cells are used to create the first immortal human cell line in the early 1950s. Starring Oprah Winfrey and Renée Elise Goldsberry. Not rated. 1 hour, 33 minutes.

Oct. 25: *The Butler* (2013)

As Cecil Gaines serves eight presidents during his tenure as a butler at the White House, the civil rights movement, Vietnam, and other major events affect his life, family, and American society. Starring Oprah Winfrey and Forest Whitaker. Rated PG-13. 2 hours and 12 minutes.

Nov. 1: *The Hundred Foot Journey* (2014)

The Kadam family leaves India for France where they open a restaurant directly across the road from Madame Mallory's Michelin-starred eatery. Starring Helen Mirren and Om Puri. Produced by Oprah Winfrey. Rated PG. 2 hours, 2 minutes.
