The New City Free Library held its meeting at the school house on Tuesday May 13 at three P.M.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mrs. Noyes reported receiving the total of \$44.25 as the result of the tag day collection taken up by the school children. A report of the last meeting was made that Mr. Koop donated \$2.00 for the purchase of a new book, and added that he would prefer to have a book about Building construction added to library.

We decided at the last meeting that only upon request the name of the person donating a book be entered into the book.

A large number of books were received at the last meeting.

Four dollars and five cents of the friends collected on tag day was used to pay for materials for librarian. A motion to use tag day money for purchases of new books was made by Mrs. Herrlein and seconded by Mrs. Karrell.

It was also decided that any members of the organization would have the privilege of selecting books for purchase.

Mrs. Noyes reported receiving a letter from Miss Burd and it was thought best to hold the entertainment some time in the Fall.

Mrs. Karrell reported that she received a letter from a friend who is a librarian in N.Y. City and that she would gladly give us some information on books. The secretary was asked to write a letter for some information.

Mrs. Feeley reported sending a letter to Mrs. Mason.

A motion was made by Mrs. Noyes and seconded by Mrs. Herrlein that we have a ten[t] on the day that we open the library to the public.

A motion was made by Mrs. Noyes and seconded by Mrs. Karrell that Mrs. Youmans should speak to Mr. Stark about making more shelves for books.

Their being no other Business the meeting was adjourned.
