A meeting of the New City Library Association was held on Thursday Dec. 2nd at 3 o'clock.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted.

Mrs. Noyes reported that she had consulted the school trustees about putting up shelves, and was told that shelves might be put up over the folding tables, but not where the chairs are piled, as the ventilating system would be interfered with.

Mr. De Bevoise offered to donate the lumber for shelves. Mrs. Youmans asked Mr. Stark if he would put up the shelves and stain the new small book case and screen. Mr. Stark agreed to do the work at small cost.

Seventy-one new books were bought for \$105.

A motion was made and seconded that we spend five dollars a month on new books.
